## **INFORMATION SHEET**

**Terms:** "Every dog" refers to basenjis used for breeding.  
"Breeder" refers to AdventureLand Basenjis  
"AKC" refers to the American Kennel Club, Inc.

**HEALTH** - all test results are available for examination.

**OFA Certification** - all dogs over the age of two have their hips radiographed and certified by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals. Every dog certified to date is GOOD or EXCELLENT rated.

**Fanconi Syndrome** – all breeding stock is tested for Fanconi using the marker test developed by the University of Missouri. Only dogs testing clear or carrier status will be used in the breeding program. Dogs that test carrier can only be bred to dogs tested as clear for Fanconi.

**Progressive Retinal Atrophy** - Every dog has an annual eye exam by a board certified ophthalmologist. To date all dogs are testing NORMAL.

**Other Eye Aliments** - All puppies at about the age of eight weeks are examined to verify the condition and health of the eye structure.

**Hemolytic Anemia** - to the best of my knowledge, breeding stock is clear for HA.

**TEMPERAMENT** - Along with selective breeding with compatible parents, early socialization is done at birth of the puppy. Proper handling and exposure to many sounds, light, activity, adult dogs, and people go a long way towards a self-assured puppy. Puppies are kept at AdventureLand until at least nine weeks of age to get the benefit of a good early socialization program.

**STRUCTURE** - Always in the pursuit of the "perfect basenji", careful consideration is given to each mating. Research of compatible pedigrees is done at great effort to blend the right two dogs that can produce above standard offspring.

## **PURCHASE TERMS**

All puppies are sold with a Sales Agreement giving certain rights and conditions to both the buyer and the breeder

All basenjis shall be registered with the American Kennel Club.

Puppies sold for non-exhibition in AKC conformation shows must be spayed or neutered with proof provided by a licensed veterinarian. Registration application is designated as LIMITED STATUS with AKC which means that should an unplanned breeding occur, the resulting offspring are unable to be registered with AKC. However, this status does not restrict the buyer from obedience, rally, lure coursing, or agility trials.

Puppies sold for exhibition (AKC shows) may be co-owned by the breeder. This will depend on the conditions agreed between the breeder and buyer.

A deposit of \$100 is suggested if a buyer wants to be assured of purchasing a puppy from AdventureLand. Deposit will be refunded if no puppies are born from a selected litter.
